The Costello House is ABCCM's Recovery Living Ministry. We are dedicated to the recovery and wellbeing of civilian men. We provide evidence-based, in-house groups as well as Case Management and supportive housing support. Our Peer Supports support the daily runnings and agenda of the Costello house. This includes but is not limited to:

- Serving meals, leading groups, maintaining rules and the safety of the house, and assisting volunteers.
- Must work well in a team-oriented atmosphere.
- Assist Case Management.
- Ability to share lived experience to support, encourage and enhance residents' treatment and recovery.
- Ability to collaborate with the program case managers to assess their own strengths and areas of growth and to develop a supervision plan.
- Ability to collaborate with residents to explore and identify barriers to accessing community resources or treatment providers.
- Ability to model and mentor recovery values, attitudes, beliefs and personal actions to encourage wellness and resilience for residents served and to promote a recovery environment in the community, residence, and workplace.
- Ability to promote a resident's opportunity for personal growth by identifying teachable moments for building relationship skills to empower the residents and enhance personal responsibility.
- Ability to model and share decisions-making tools to enhance a residents healthy decision-making process.
